About the Scholarship

During the midst of the pandemic in 2020, we were faced with canceling our tournament due to the concerns surrounding COVID-19. In its place, we decided to launch our own scholarship in order to raise money for the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention while also awarding money to the deserving students of our community. Our scholarship aims to not only assist aspiring students in pursuing further education but to also evoke thought and start conversation among youth and adults alike, regarding the issue of mental health and suicide prevention.

Application Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking graduating seniors who are residents of the city of Woburn, MA.
- * Applicants must have a minimum weighted GPA of 2.5 and plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college or technical school.
- * Scholarship funds will be paid **for the first semester of the student's first year directly to the college** and not to the student. It will be the student's responsibility to submit to us at that time an invoice for first semester tuition and fees, student ID number and college information.
- * Two \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded to one boy and one girl.
- * Application deadline is **April 10, 2021**, to be received by the Kick It Team. Late applications are not accepted.
